#### 2016/BMCSC012 OFFICER RECOMMENDATION/COMMITTEE DECISION:

That the Bencubbin Multipurpose Complex Steering Committee receive the information tendered by WALGA that it is a decision for the Chief Executive Officer to make in regards to the Tender process.

#### BACKGROUND:

At its meeting held on 6 April 2016, the committee recommended to Council "that Council calls for tenders based on the draft procurement plan for the design and redevelopment of the Bencubbin Multipurpose Complex as provided by WALGA".

Council met on 19 April 2016 and considered the committee recommendation and resolved as follows:

That Council refers the matter of calling tenders for the design and construction of the Bencubbin Multipurpose Complex to the BMCSC for more discussion and consideration.

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#### COMMENT:

The Acting CEO (ACEO) has requested and received two (2) reports from WALGA concerning the two (2) tendering methods. The second (2<sup>nd</sup>) report raises a series of questions which may need to be addressed. The ACEO and Community Development

Officer (CDO) have addressed the questions which appear relevant to the Shire and are pursuing answers.

Regardless of the answers WALGA have made a definite recommendation to Council in the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) report. It reads as follows:

"It is recommended that the Shire of Mt Marshall undertake the traditional two step approach to ensure that the community receives a value outcome with minimal exposure to risk".

WALGA have given strong advice that the tender process rests with the Chief Executive Officer and it is only for Council to determine which is the successful tender. This being the case, the CEO has determined that the two (2) tender process will be followed based on both written and verbal advice from WALGA.

Council will be advised of this at its next meeting scheduled for 17 May 2016.
