Below is a timeline of progress regarding the Bencubbin Recreation Complex Redevelopment:

Tender Let: 9 February

Tender closed: 9 March
Tender Evaluation: 14 March
Council Item: 21 March

Negotiations (preferred tenderer): From 27 March (ongoing)

Steering Group Meetings: 21 April & 5 May

As can be seen from the above timeline, a preferred tenderer has been identified, and Council have given their approval for negotiations to take place between them and Council representatives. The Steering Group have been consulted regarding all cost saving changes to the original planning.

Site Architecture have prepared a 'cost saving sketch' for the preferred tenderer to provide a revised quotation. This document is not necessarily the final document, but a copy of this draft can be viewed at the front counter of the Shire offices during business hours. Please feel free to call in and have a look.

Negotiations are still ongoing, with all parties hopeful that costing within budget can soon be achieved. Once that situation has been reached, further community information will be provided, especially regarding any revised timeframe for the building works to take place.

LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT - TOWN SITE NUMBERING OF HOUSES

A request from our local emergency services to have house numbers visible to attending emergency services crews has resulted in the Shire purchasing numbers for **all** houses in the town sites of Bencubbin and Beacon. The numbers are black on white and are reflective to make them visible at night time.

Some numbers have been attached to Shire housing already with the remaining numbers to be installed in the coming weeks. It is anticipated that Shire staff will complete this work in the week commencing Monday 22nd May 2017, starting in Bencubbin and then moving on to Beacon.

As you would be aware not all houses are the same and the numbers may be placed in different positions, depending on the building. Shire staff will endeavour to install the numbers in the most effective position, which can be seen from the road side by emergency services.

If you are at home, Shire staff will liaise with residents when completing this work.

Please note, it is not mandatory that you have your number displayed, but not doing so may result in a time delay for the arrival of emergency services. If you do not want the number attached to your house please advise Shire staff and they will comply with your wishes.

Many residents may be familiar with using their "Lot" number as their address. Once your house number has been installed please use this number as your residential address in the event of an emergency. House numbers are programmed in to all GPS systems, which do not recognise lot numbers, and house numbers are required by the 000 call centre.
