

NORTH EASTERN WHEATBELT REGION OF COUNCILS (NEWROC) SUCCESSFUL TELECOMMUNICATIONS GRANT

The Shire along with 5 other member Shires of NEWROC have been successful in their Building Better Regions Fund application to improve digital telecommunications across the Wheatbelt. In a competitive funding round with over 500 applications received and considered, this project was one of the 100 odd successful applicants who will receive a funding boost from the Federal Government.

With \$700,000 of funding, NEWROC will work with South Western Wireless to deliver a \$958,500 project across the North Eastern Wheatbelt. The 6 NEWROC member Shires including the Shire of Mt Marshall will fund the balance of the project. Residents, businesses and visitors will benefit from fast, fixed wireless access to the digital network, leading to our regional area being a more attractive place to work, live and play.
