BUSH FIRE CONTROL OFFICERS

The Shire has been experiencing a dwindling of registered Bush Fire Control Officers in recent years having lost several Officers. Unfortunately replacements have not been found and this has now left areas of the Shire without a Bush Fire Control Officer. The next five years could see numbers of available Bush Fire Control Officers further decrease due to retirements and Officers leaving the area.

With this in mind, Shire staff, together with our DFES Area Manager, are looking at conducting some bush fire training in February 2018 to bring interested volunteers up to a level where they can be nominated as Bush Fire Control Officers. Even if you don't intend to take on the role of Bush Fire Control Officer the opportunity is available to complete the Introduction to Fire Fighting as a pre requisite to joining your local brigade.

Bush Fire training is now mostly computer based but there is some basic training which is conducted face to face. Introduction to Fire Fighting is a pre requisite to all training and can be presented by our Area Manager. Unfortunately, like all courses, it takes a day and a half to complete.

While I realise everyone is in the middle of harvest, to enable the course to be conducted in February 2018, I require numbers of participants as soon as possible.
