ROADWORKS

The railway crossing along the **Koorda-Bullfinch Rd** near the intersection of Marshall Rock South Road, Bencubbin will be undergoing some works from **6 June**. ARC Infrastructure are scheduled to do works on the rail way track with the Shire carrying out road widening once the track work is completed.

A small unsealed detour has been created for use while ARC carry out the track works and we ask that all drivers use caution and obey signs when travelling through the crossing.

The intersection of the **Beacon-Bencubbin Rd** and **Burakin-Wialki Rd** in **Beacon** is undergoing widening works. This is in preparation for an increase of the Restricted Vehicle Access (RAV) rating. The works will ensure the road meets Main Roads conditions for an RAV rating of seven (7). The roads and intersection will remain open while the works are carried out but please travel through the area with caution.

ARE YOU REMEMBERING TO RECYCLE?

The Shire is a drop off point for all of your old mobiles which will ensure they stay out of landfill and instead are recycled in an environmentally sound way. Mobile phones should never be thrown out. They are not biodegradable and may contain some potentially environmentally hazardous material.
