BACKGROUND:

At the Bush Fire Advisory Committee meeting held on Friday 24 September 2010 a proposal to install a UHF radio repeater network was submitted by Mr Stuart Hopwood. The committee's recommendation to Council was that the proposal be passed on to the Local Emergency Management Committee for its comments.

COMMENT:

FESA is in the process of installing a new statewide radio network which will incorporate both VHF and UHF in the same two way radio, it would be my recommendation that Mr Hopwood's proposal be noted and if FESA's new system is not adequate we look at other alternatives.

My discussions with Mobile Masters (Council's two way radio technicians) is that the Department of Communications are reluctant to issue radio repeater sites and that if you were successful you are probably looking at a cost of between \$10,000 and \$13,000.
