PARLIAMENTARY INQUIRY INTO LOCAL GOVERNMENT

On 26 June 2019 the Select Committee into Local Government was established by the Legislative Council to inquire into how well the system of Local Government is functioning in Western Australia, with particular reference to:

- Whether the *Local Government Act 1995* and the related legislation is generally suitable in its scope, construction and application;
- The scope of activities of Local Government;
- The role of the Department of State administering the *Local Government Act 1995* and related legislation;
- The role of Elected Members and Chief Executive Officers/employees and whether these are clearly defined, delineated, understood and accepted;
- The funding and financial management of Local Governments;
- And any other related matters the Select Committee identifies as worthy of examination and Report.

As part of its consultation process, the Committee invites you to provide a written submission on one or more of the above Terms of Reference. The closing date for submissions is 4.00pm on Friday, 23 August 2019.
