ANNUAL BUDGET 2020/2021

The Shire's annual budget for 2020/21 was set at the Council meeting held Friday 31 July 2020. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic Council resolved not to levy any increase on the rates pool for the 2020/21 financial year. It is important that residents understand that although the total amount of rates levied has remained the same, due to valuation changes individual rates may go up or down.

As residents will no doubt be aware the redevelopment of the Mt Marshall Aquatic Facility is quickly reaching completion. The new 25m pool and toddler pool will be open in time for the upcoming swimming season. Watch the local papers for information regarding opening dates, times and activities.

The Club Support and Economic Development Funds have been maintained with the previous year's fund amounts retained. The grant funding for both funds will be open soon, so again please watch the local press for details.

The Shire are excited to have been awarded a lease over a large area of Waddouring Dam and have budgeted to implement some access improvements to the area. Although Waddouring is not currently open to the public once the budgeted works have been undertaken the Shire will have another excellent location for the local community and tourists to walk, picnic and enjoy the water

The following major projects are included in the 2020/21 Annual Budget:

- Various Capital Works to maintain housing stock
- Road access and car park improvements at Beacon Air Strip
- Bowling Green upgrade/replacement (Bencubbin and Beacon)
- Road widening and safety improvements at Waddouring Dam
- Various improvements at both day care facilities
- Footpath construction
- Various Road Reconstructions
- Sandalwood Shops paving at rear
