Plant Operator

A vacancy exists for a full time Plant Operator working from the Bencubbin depot (38hrs/wk). You will be required to operate a variety of Shire plant and equipment however the main task for this position is to operate the Shire's prime mover within the construction crew.

A 'HC' class driver's license is a minimum requirement for the position. Remuneration will be according to Level 4 - 5 of the Local Government Industry Award 2010 depending on experience and Shire housing may be negotiated with the successful applicant.

Parks and Gardens Officer

The Shire of Mt Marshall is seeking a competent and enthusiastic Parks and Gardens Officer to provide attentive care for our numerous parks and gardens, recreation centres, fully grassed reticulated oval, caravan parks, and botanic gardens.

The job is based in Bencubbin and involves a diverse range of duties and will be ideal for you if you like variety in your work and are self motivated.

A 'C' class driver's license is a minimum requirement for the position and remuneration is in accordance with Level 4 - 5 of the Local Government Industry Award 2010, dependant on experience. Subsidised Shire housing may be provided and negotiated with the preferred applicant.

Part Time Cleaner — Beacon

A vacancy exists for a part time Cleaner in Beacon (25hrs/wk). Duties will include (but not limited to) the cleaning of the recreation complex, gymnasium, Beacon Hall and tourist accommodation.

LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT EXERCISE 2021

On Monday 2nd August 2021 the Shire of Mt Marshall's Local Emergency Management Committee carried out the annual Local Emergency Management Exercise as a part of the Local Emergency Management Arrangements to test the preparedness of local emergency services and the Shire.

The exercise was attended by Bencubbin Police, Department of Fire and Emergency Services personnel, Department of Communities personnel, Welbungin Bushfire Brigade, St John's volunteer ambulance officers, the Bencubbin Primary School and Shire staff. Traffic Management and victim was provided by Shire staff. Regulatory Officer, Meg Wyatt and Community Development Officer, Rebecca Watson were in charge of setting up and running the evacuation centre.

The exercise gave all emergency service agencies the opportunity to test their skills and allowed for the coordination and communication between all emergency response organisations to be tested. The exercise also allowed for the Bencubbin Primary School to test their evacuation procedures and the Shire to test the setting up and management of the evacuation centre.
