Plant Operator

A vacancy exists for a full time Plant Operator working from the Bencubbin depot (38hrs/wk). You will be required to operate a variety of Shire plant and equipment however the main task for this position is to operate the Shire's prime mover within the construction crew.

A 'HC' class driver's license is a minimum requirement for the position. Remuneration will be according to Level 4 - 5 of the Local Government Industry Award 2010 depending on experience and Shire housing may be negotiated with the successful applicant.

Parks and Gardens Officer

The Shire of Mt Marshall is seeking a competent and enthusiastic Parks and Gardens Officer to provide attentive care for our numerous parks and gardens, recreation centres, fully grassed reticulated oval, caravan parks, and botanic gardens.

The job is based in Bencubbin and involves a diverse range of duties and will be ideal for you if you like variety in your work and are self motivated.

A 'C' class driver's license is a minimum requirement for the position and remuneration is in accordance with Level 4 - 5 of the Local Government Industry Award 2010, dependant on experience. Subsidised Shire housing may be provided and negotiated with the preferred applicant.

Part Time Cleaner — Beacon

A vacancy exists for a part time Cleaner in Beacon (25hrs/wk). Duties will include (but not limited to) the cleaning of the recreation complex, gymnasium, Beacon Hall and tourist accommodation.

CYCLONE SEROJA - Primary Producer Recovery Grant Program

Key features of the Program are:

- The Primary Producer Recovery Grant Program provides financial assistance to primary producers to help pay for the costs of clean-up and reinstatement of primary production enterprises that suffered direct damage as a result of STC Seroja.
- The maximum grant amount is \$25,000 and multiple applications may be submitted by an applicant until the maximum amount is reached.

Are you Eligible?

To help decide whether you are eligible to apply for funds under this scheme, you should answer yes to these questions:

- I am a primary producer, hold a current Australian Business Number (ABN) that I held at the time of STC Seroja (11-12 April 2021) and are registered for GST.
- My primary production enterprise is located in the defined disaster area, was operational at the time of STC Seroja and suffered direct damage as a result of STC Seroja.
- I intend to re-establish my primary production enterprise in the defined disaster area.
