MT MARSHALL RED CARD FOX SHOOT

Thank you to all the teams that participated in the 2022 Red Card Fox Shoot on Friday Night. In total the 5 teams recorded a total of 102 foxes, 165 rabbits and 12 wild cats.

Across a wide range of agricultural sectors, rabbits caused a loss of \$216.3 million in 2013/14. Foxes caused a loss of \$28.4 million dollars. Feral cats were not included in the report, but the Pestsmart website estimates that the cost of cats is \$2 million per year for management and research, while the loss of birds to preying cats has been estimated to be \$144 million annually. Feral cats have contributed to the extinction of at least 27 mammal species Australia wide and currently endanger 147 other Australian mammals, bird, reptiles and frogs. In addition, they transmit toxoplasmosis to humans, domestic stock and wildlife. Foxes impacted upon up to 84 threatened species, eight of which were already listed at 'high risk' of extinction.

Congratulations to the Tomas Team who took out the highest score for the event. Well done to

all the teams who came together to eradicate vermin from the district and help raise money for the Regional Men's Health Initiative.
