Please be advised that there will be **NO licensing services** available on **Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 February**. This is to allow





REFUSE FACILITIES

Both Beacon and Bencubbin waste facilities have only a limited life and there is a great expense in both the closing and rehabilitation of the waste sites and the creation of new sites. There is also an expense with having to maintain the facilities and dig new trenches.

One way in which to extend the life of the tip and save ratepayer dollars is to correctly separate waste into the defined areas within the waste facility. Items such as steel and household furniture should not be disposed of in the household waste trench.

What can be accepted and where do I put it?

Household Waste Area

Anything that cannot be separated into one of the other areas Plus building rubble/cladding materials/ masonry/pavers/tiles/timber Sheet glass, bottles, jars etc No furniture or mattresses **Car Bodies Area** *No car parts such as windscreens bumpers etc—these are to go into Metal/steel area or household waste area

Asbestos Area

*Note—asbestos can only be accepted by appointment. Please contact the shire on 08 9685 1202 to book an appointment

Whitegoods / Electrical Appliances Area

All white goods All electrical appliances *Note—all whitegoods with refrigerated gasses must be de-gassed before being placed in the waste facility.

Green Waste Area

plants, cuttings, clippings etc. Timber (scrap) and wooden furniture green waste only—no plastic pots, steel the or waste of any other kind please

Wire & Metal Area

Wire/steel/metal sheeting

BUSHFIRE INFORMATION

Shire of Mt Marshall

Bush Fire Act 1954

Restricted Burning Time

All burning is **Restricted** in the Shire of Mt Marshall from **Monday 1 February 2016 to Tuesday 15 March 2016.** During this time a Permit to Burn is required.

Farmers are advised that Permits will only be issued on a daily basis and are reminded that certain conditions are endorsed on the Permit.

One important condition is that **burning cannot be carried out** on the day if a **Very High**, **Extreme or above Fire Danger has been issued by the Bureau of Meteorology**.

Please check BOM website for further information or contact your nearest Bush Fire Control Officer.

Permits can be issued by Jack Walker at the Shire office and permit holders are also reminded to read the "Obligations of the permit holder" prior to burning.

BURNING OF GARDEN REFUSE AND RUBBISH

Garden refuse and rubbish may be burnt at any time, day or night, in a properly constructed incinerator designed to prevent the escape of sparks or burning material.

Garden refuse and rubbish burnt on the ground may be burnt only between the hours of 6 o'clock in the evening and 11 o'clock of the same day and must be completely extinguished no later than midnight on that day.

If you are considering burning garden refuse please ensure that you do not leave the fire unattended and have running water available.

During this period there are still **Extreme** weather conditions and care should be taken before considering any burning.
