SHIRE OF MT MARSHALL—A WATERWISE COUNCIL

The Waterwise Council Program is run through a joint partnership between Water Corporation and the Department of Water, and supports local governments to improve water efficiency in their operations and liveability in their communities.

The Shire has recently been endorsed through the program and Cr Tony Sachse attended the ceremony held in Perth receiving this recognition on behalf of the Shire. The Shire had to meet a set of criteria as listed below to obtain this status and were amongst 10 other newly endorsed local governments to receive this recognition.

Criteria

1. Council Commitment
2. Review Shire water consumption and create a water efficiency action plan for potable and non-potable water sources for all Shire operations and the community.
3. Ensure that appropriate staff members complete free waterwise training
4. No breaches of groundwater licence terms or conditions set by the Department of Water, and no breaches of scheme water usage issued by Water Corporation in the past 12 months. This includes permanent water efficiency measures.
