## 2018/2019 ANNUAL BUDGET REVIEW

The Shire's annual budget for 2018/19 was set at the special Council meeting held Friday 10 August 2018. The general rate will increase by 3%

The swimming pool at the **Mt Marshall Aquatic Complex** will be closed again this year. Arrangements will again be made to bus school children from Beacon and Bencubbin to nearby swimming pools for in-term swimming classes. You will likely be aware that community consultation has taken place regarding the future of aquatic facilities in the Shire. A decision based upon that consultation should be made by Council before the end of 2018.

The Economic Development Fund has been continued (although the amount available reduced in line with demand from last year). The grant funding will be open for applications in September, so watch the local press for details.

The following major projects are included in the 2018/19 Annual Budget:

- Upgrade of the Airstrip at Beacon, funded through Federal, State and Shire funds
- Implementation of a 'workers camp' in Beacon, to replace the Beacon Barracks which are due to close at the end of 2018
- CEACA aged care housing, with units due to be constructed in Bencubbin and Beacon
- The purchase of a new community bus, with the old bus being retained and moved to Beacon to improve ease of use for residents in and around Beacon
- Purchase of 2 new graders
- Upgrade works in both the administration centre and depot in Bencubbin
- A \$1.7 million road construction program
- Repair of the Bencubbin Hall roof (grant funding dependant)
- Refurbishment of the old police station museum
- Support for the Beacon Country Music Community Concert
- Footpath construction
