During the session Brigade members successfully logged on to the DFES Volunteer Extranet training portal which allowed them to complete a computer based AIMMS Awareness course (20 minutes) and apply for some face to face training.

It has been identified that further Bush Fire training is required and therefore a 1 day Introduction to Fire Fighting has been arranged for Friday 8 March 2019, commencing at 8.00am. The course will be held at the Bencubbin Multipurpose Complex and should be completed by 4.00pm. Catering will be provided.

If you are interested in attending the training it is important that I receive your expression of interest two weeks prior to the event. It is also important that you are a registered member of your Bush Fire Brigade and have a volunteer number. This will enable you to be registered on the volunteer portal.

Little Bee's Family Day Care has been successfully operating since July 2015 with many families utilising the service from Mt Marshall & surrounds.

The Shire of Mt Marshall is seeking a relief Coordinator to run the 'in-venue' Family Day Care service during the year. The service operates from Bencubbin every Monday to Wednesday and Beacon every Thursday however any proposed alterations to this schedule can be discussed with interested candidates.

All planning and preparation during relief periods will be provided by our current coordinator and you will operate under the support of the Greater Beginnings Family Day Care Scheme and the Shire.

Requirements of the role include;

- Current National police check or willing to obtain
- Working with Children check clearance or willing to obtain
- Current First Aid certificate and Asthma & Anaphylactic training or willing to obtain
- Accredited Food Safe certificates or willing to obtain
- Demonstrable commitment to the social, emotional, intellectual and physical needs of children

BUSHFIRE INFORMATION

Shire of Mt Marshall Bush Fire Act 1954 Restricted Burning Time

All burning is **Restricted** in the Shire of Mt Marshall from **Friday 1 February 2019 to Friday 15 March 2019.** During this time a Permit to Burn is required.

Farmers are advised that Permits will only be issued on a daily basis and are reminded that certain conditions are endorsed on the Permit.

One important condition is that **burning cannot be carried out** on the day if a **Very High, Extreme or above Fire Danger has been issued by the Bureau of Meteorology.**

Please check BOM website for further information or contact your nearest Bush Fire Control Officer.

Permits can be issued by Jack Walker at the Shire office and permit holders are also reminded to read the "Obligations of the permit holder" prior to burning.

BURNING OF GARDEN REFUSE AND RUBBISH

Garden refuse and rubbish may be burnt at any time, day or night, in a properly constructed incinerator designed to prevent the escape of sparks or burning material. Garden refuse and rubbish burnt on the ground may be burnt only between the hours of 6 o'clock in the evening and 11 o'clock of the same day and must be completely extinguished no later than midnight on that day.

If you are considering burning garden refuse please ensure that you do not leave the fire unattended and have running water available.

During this period there are still **Extreme** weather conditions and care should be taken before considering any burning.
