- Demonstrable commitment to the social, emotional, intellectual and physical needs of children

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST SOUGHT - BUSH FIRE TRAINING

On Friday 8 February, 2019 several members of the Welbungin Bush Fire Brigade attended an information session with DFES staff from Northam. During the session Brigade members successfully logged on to the DFES Volunteer Extranet training portal which allowed them to complete a computer based AIMMS Awareness course (20 minutes) and apply for some face to face training.

It has been identified that further Bush Fire training is required and therefore a 1 day Introduction to Fire Fighting has been arranged for Friday 8 March 2019, commencing at 8.00am. The course will be held at the Bencubbin Multipurpose Complex and should be completed by 4.00pm. Catering will be provided.

If you are interested in attending the training it is important that I receive your expression of interest two weeks prior to the event. It is also important that you are a registered member of your Bush Fire Brigade and have a volunteer number. This will enable you to be registered on the volunteer portal.

POSITION VACANT **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICER**

Applications are sought from suitably qualified/experienced persons to undertake the position of Community Development Officer. The position is a full time position, working 38 hours per week from the Shire's administration centre based in Bencubbin.

The position will require the successful incumbent working in consultation with the community to co-ordinate the community development needs of the Shire particularly working with families and youth groups. A committed team and consultative approach is sought to work in a rural community environment and be dedicated to community social capacity building.
