NSRF APPLICATION SUCCESSFUL Some excellent news was announced last week with the Shire of Mt Marshall being one of only five local governments in the state to receive funding from the National Stronger Regions Fund (NSRF). Funding has been approved up to \$990,000 towards the redevelopment of a Multipurpose Complex in

Bencubbin. Council staff can be congratulated on their efforts in securing this funding and continue to work with Tredwell Consultancy on the Shire of Mt Marshall Sporting and Recreation Plan in the hope of a draft plan being presented to Council at the May Ordinary Council meeting.
